General Information

The camp is planned to provide comprehensive skill instruction for intermediate and beginning players. Emphasis will be placed on fundamentals, individual skill development, and team strategy. The camp will also include guest lectures, demonstrations, daily competitions, and awards to contest winners and team champions.
